It should be noted: With the intentionally small cohorts at H.I.S., one should be cautious when drawing conclusions or inferences, as the data sets may be too small to be statistically reliable and may produce misleading information.

For privacy reasons, we do not provide individual student scores, and even though we are extraordinarily proud of our higher scoring students, we do not provide our highest scores. The reason for this is that it would be relatively simple to identify individual graduates from the very small cohorts. Our duty to ensure the privacy of the individual outweighs the desire for public disclosure of this information.

H.I.S. is proud that our students have been successful in the many years of the IB Diploma Programme. In most instances, individual students have achieved results exceeding their expectations. As an international school, it is very satisfying to have a high ratio of the coveted bilingual diplomas awarded.

The majority of our graduates have continued onto further study in colleges and universities around the world. Last year's graduates are studying in the USA, the UK, Asia, and various European destinations, including the world-class universities here in Heidelberg.

Graduates from previous years can be found studying in Oxford, Edinburgh, London, Bath, York, Swansea, Glasgow, Manchester and Southampton in the UK. Seoul in the Republic of Korea, Paris, Sofia, Budapest, Amsterdam & Leiden as well as more locally in Karlsruhe, Kaiserslautern and of course, here in Heidelberg at SRH and Universität Heidelberg.

Our past students are studying for a wide range of undergraduate and postgraduate degrees including: medicine, international law, chemistry, business management, IT & computer science, biosciences, nursing, education, art & design, sociology and environmental sciences. Some students from our first cohorts have already completed their degrees and have entered the workplace or pursuing higher education studying for Masters and Doctoral degrees.
